STRATEGIES FOR ADRA

1. Develop policy on non-lawyers in all facets of ADR:
2. Urgently consider the accreditation of training courses, in conjunction with LEADR
3. Publicise its recommendations on training
4. Write to the Minister, seeking ADRA'S representation on the Advisory Council
5. Offer a critique of the LRC Report  
Write to the Minister requesting that ADRA should be represented on the Advisory Council
6. Make its views known to the Chief Justice, and the LRC on the role of non-lawyer mediators
7. Support members who wish to be represented on the LRC Database
8. Develop a 'watchdog' role to public discussion of mediation; to ensure that the appropriate terminology is used, and the public is educated as to the real role of the mediator
